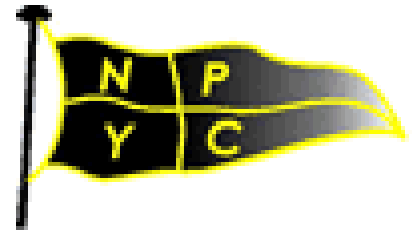

NOTICE OF RACE

1 The Organizing Authority

1.1 The organising authority is the New Plymouth Yacht Club.

2 Rules

2.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

2.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 and Part 5 [Category C] shall apply.

3 Changes to Racing Rules

3.1 The Racing Rules will be changed in accordance with rule 86 as follows:

Rule 61.1 (a) will be altered Optimist, P Class and Starlings entered in this regatta will not be exempt from displaying a protest flag.

4 Eligibility and Entry

4.1 The regatta is open to all classes that comply with Class Rules. If insufficient entries are received to make up a class (a minimum of 3 yachts), yachts will be grouped into Open Classes.

4.2 Entries will be accepted until 09:00 hrs, 8th February 2014 by completing the attached entry form accompanied by a fee of \$15.00 for junior classes or \$35.00 per boat for senior classes.

4.3 No late entry fee applies.

4.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognized by Yachting New Zealand.

5 Schedule of Events

5.1 Registration

5.1.1 8th February 2014 – 08:00 to 09:00 hours at NPYC.

5.2 Briefing:

5.2.1 8th February 2014 at 09:00 hrs at New Plymouth Yacht Club.

5.3 Racing Schedule

	Junior Fleets	Seniors & Starling Fleets
Saturday 8th February	Race 1 First warning signal 10:25 hrs Race 2 back to back. Break for lunch Race 3 and 4 back to back.	Race 1 First warning signal 10:55 hrs Race 2 and 3 back to back.
Sunday 9th February	Race 5 First warning signal 9:55 hrs. Race 6 and 7 back to back.	Race 4 First warning signal 9:55 hrs. Race 5 and 6 back to back.

5.4 At the discretion of the race officers additional races maybe held on the Sunday to make up for any lost on the Saturday, subject to the latest time for the last warning signal being 14:55 hrs.

5.5 Inside harbour course – Optimist Green and Open fleets and Starling classes
Outside harbour course – All senior classes.

6 Prize giving

6.1 Prize giving will be held as soon as possible after completion of racing on Sunday.

7 Sailing Instructions

7.1 The NPYC Sailing Instructions will apply as amended below. Additional copies be available will be available for visitors at registration.

8 Racing Area

8.1 The races will be held in the vicinity of Port Taranaki.

8.2 The courses may be windward leeward or triangle windward/leeward or a combination thereof.

9 Alternative Penalties

9.1 Refer NPYC sailing instructions

10 Prizes

10.1 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes will be awarded in each class, dependent on number of entries.

11 Team Support Boats

11.1 Team Support boats will be allowed.

11.2 Boats must be registered with the Organizing Authority at registration (clause 5.1).

12 Launching

12.1 All dinghies' must be launched and retrieved from the beach in front of the Yacht Club.

12.2 Trailer yachts are to be launched and retrieved from either the boat ramp or the beach in front of the Yacht Club.
