Dear Sailors and Parents

Congratulations to all sailors who have competed in the Icebreaker Regatta and the 2013 Stack Winter Champs. A particular well done to Scott McKenzie 1st, Robbie McCutcheon 2nd and Lewis Anderson 3rd in Open Fleet and Caleb Armit 1st, Antony van Hameren 2nd and Lachlan Stewart 3rd in Green Fleet at the Stack Winter Champs.

Important Change to selection for the Asian Championship

The NZIODA committee voted on the change required to ensure team selection for the 2014 Asian Champs, which will be held before our National Championship.

The criteria for the 2014 IODA Asian Champs selection is:

"Selection will be based on a sailors ranking after the 2013 North Island Championship to be held at New Plymouth 15th-17th November 2013. Therefore you must attend this regatta to be considered as this will be the only ranking regatta for 2014 NZIODA Asian team selection. Positions will be offered from the first ranked sailor downwards until the team places are filled (a total of 7 sailors will attend, with a minimum of two from either gender e.g. 5 girls and 2 boys or vice-versa). If a sailor elects to take up a position offered and attends the 2014 Asian Championship, the sailor will not be eligible for selection in any other 2014 IODA Continental or World Championships supported by NZIODA - regardless of their final ranking from the NZIODA ranking regattas or result at the NZIODA National Championship (for clarity this includes World's team selection, North American Champs and European Champs)". If a sailor turns down the opportunity to represent NZIODA at the 2014 Asian Champs they will remain eligible for the













remaining international regattas as named above and would need to qualify as per the usual qualification process.

Sailors will have <u>seven days</u> after the 2013 North Island Champs in which to confirm the offer for selection as we have already had to request a registration extension. A presentation on Bahrain as a location, that includes some of the costs is attached as well as the NOR (please note that NOR's are subject to updates). Parents considering attending if their sailor looks in contention will need to research the costs now so a quick decision can be made. We'd also ask sailors and parents to consider timing and cost of attending any training events before departure, as these are equally as important as the regatta itself to ensure the team is well prepared. Any questions about the cost or commitment needed are welcomed by the committee and several coaches will also be able to assist so please ask.

2 NZIODA Registration

Thank you to all of those who have registered and paid for 2013/14. If you are yet to join or pay please do so as soon as possible so that you stay on the NZIODA database, are able to compete at the NZIODA North Islands and eligible for international travelling team selection. To register go to the NZIODA web www.optimist.org.nz

Once registered, a receipt will be sent to you. To obtain your registration number multiply your receipt number by 10 and add 1 for the first sailor appearing on the receipt and add 2 for the second, three for the third and so on. E.g. if your receipt number is 123 your registration number for the first sailor will be 1231, the second 1232 etc.
