# NZIODA Registration

Remember all Green and Open Fleet sailors attending an NZIODA regatta (the next one is the Auckland Champs) you must join NZIODA. To register go to the NZIODA web <a href="https://www.optimist.org.nz">www.optimist.org.nz</a> and click on Club Hub

Once registered, a receipt will be sent to you. To obtain your registration number multiply your receipt number by 10 and add 1 for the first sailor appearing on the receipt and add 2 for the second, three for the third and so on. E.g. if your receipt number is 123 your registration number for the first sailor will be 1231, the second 1232 etc.
