NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.

- 1.3 The Tauranga Cup Rules and Conditions will apply.

- 1.4 Under rule 86, *Changes to The Racing Rules* the following racing rules will be changed as follows:
 - Rules 35, A4 and A5 will be changed to state that boats still racing but failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be given a finishing position based on the last mark they rounded. Their score will be greater than any boat who rounded further marks or who finished,
 - Rule 40 will be changed to require personal floatation devices to be worn at all times while afloat,
 - Rule 60.1(a) will be changed to state that a competitor cannot protest another boat or competitor for breaches of some specific parts of the Sailing Instructions,
 - Rules A4 and A5 will be changed to state that a boat starting later than 4

minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start.

The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules.

- 1.5 For protests where only a Rule of Part 2, or Rule 31 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing. The arbitration process and penalties applied will be in accordance with Yachting New Zealand Regulation 4.5.5, *Arbitration*.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the P Class that comply with the Class Rules and have a current P Class National Certificate in the name of the current owner.

- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached Entry Form and either;

- i. sending it together with the required fee, to

and depositing the required entry fee into the BOIYC bank account number 12 3102 0001569 01.

Reference the payment with "P Class" and your sail number,

by 1700 hours on Friday, 26th December, 2016.

- 2.3 Late entries may be accepted up until 1700hrs on Monday 11th January, 2016, at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

- 2.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.

- 2.5 Each competitor shall be under the age of 17 years on 31st January, 2016.

- 2.6 The following documents must be provided at registration;

- i. proof of yacht club membership,
ii. P Class National Certificate,

- iii. copy of competitor's birth certificate.

3 CLASSIFICATION

There are no classification requirements in accordance with RRS 79.

4 FEES

- 4.1 The required entry fee is \$165.

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 *Registration:*

Tuesday 12th January, 2016

From 1000 to 1600, at the Bay of Islands Yacht Club.

5.2 *Measurement and Inspection:*

Tuesday 12th January, 2016

From 1000 to 1600, at the Bay of Islands Yacht Club.

5.3 *Briefing:*

Wednesday 13th January, 2015

At 0930, at the Bay of Islands Yacht Club.

5.4 *Dates of racing:*

The event shall consist of a series of up to 6 races – (refer schedule below).

Day 3	Fri 15 th January	1000	3

- 5.5 Races may be sailed back-to-back.

- 5.5A Race Committee reserves the right to schedule on more race each day to ensure a series is completed.

- 5.6 On Friday 15th January, 2015 no warning signal will be made after 1530 hours.

5.7 Prize giving will be held on the evening of Friday 15th January, 2015.

6 MEASUREMENTS

6.1 Each boat shall be presented to the regatta measurer for measurement and inspection (NOR 6.2 above).

Competitors shall use one hull, one set of foils, one mast, one boom and one sail for the entire championships, all of which shall have been measured and marked at the official measuring.

In addition, spot measurement and safety checks may be conducted at any time throughout the regatta.

6.2 Beach trolleys shall be prominently marked with the boat's sail number.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration on Tuesday 12th January, 2016, at the Bay of Islands Yacht Club.

8 VENUE

8.1 Bay of Islands Yacht Club, Waitangi

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Windward/Leeward and/or Triangle Windward/Leeward.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

Appendix P will apply.

11 SCORING

11.1 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12 SUPPORT BOATS

- 12.1 All support boats must register with the Organising Authority at registration and nominate the boat(s) they support.
- 12.2 Team leaders, coaches, and other support personnel shall comply with NOR 14.

13 LAUNCHING AND STORAGE

- 13.1 All competing boats shall be kept on the lawn at Bay of Islands Yacht Club, unless instructed otherwise by the Organising Authority.
- 13.2 All competing boats shall be launched from the Small Boat Ramp at Bay of Islands Yacht Club, unless instructed otherwise by the Organising Authority.
- 13.3 No vehicles are allowed on the Small Boat Ramp. Support boats will be launched upstream of the Waitangi bridge at the public launching ramp.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

15 PRIZES

- 15.1 Prizes will be awarded as follows:
- Tauranga Cup - highest ranking sailor from the overall results,
 - Memorial Cup - second placed sailor in the overall results,
 - Carter Cup - third placed sailor in the overall results,
 - Naomi James Challenge Trophy - highest placed female in the overall results,
 - Harken Trophy - second highest placed female in the overall results,
 - Harry Highet Silver Salver - winner of the Invitation / Practise race,
 - Murrays Bay Cup - highest placed first time competitor,
 - Farr and Associates Trophy - youngest competitor in top ten overall,
 - Franklin Plumbing Trophy - club of the Tauranga Cup winner.
- 15.2 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority or the NZ P Class Association.

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
