Please circulate the email to your sailors as it contains important information and reminders.

Attached also are the Sailing instructions and course diagrams for the Anchor Aims Games Yachting Championship supported again this year by NZ Windows.

To assist with registration on Saturday afternoon please ensure your sailors have the following:

- 1. A whistle attached to their PDF (life jacket)
- 2. A mast collar (prevents the rig from falling out of the boat when capsized)
- 3. 3 straps on each flotation air bag that are in good condition
- 4. A clip or device to prevent the rudder from falling off in the event of a capsize
- 5. A tow rope
- 6. Sail numbers on hull that match the sail

Remember all boats must pass safety checks on Saturday afternoon in order for the sailor to complete. These checks are basics for safety afloat/ safety for the individual sailor, safety management of the fleet and the accurate recording of results.

A protest flag is not needed.

Therefore they must be adhered to - no exceptions.

The team here in Tauranga are well organised and looking forward to running an excellent regatta for you all.

I hope you all enjoy yourselves both on and off the water.
